



1 Camperdown and Darlington Campuses

At the centre of the University lies Camperdown Campus, home of Australia's leading research and teaching in the sciences, arts and humanities for more than 150 years. Located in the heart of the inner west, one of Sydney's great cultural hubs, it is a short distance from the city with access to all major transport routes.

The Camperdown Campus houses sporting ovals, cafes, Fisher Library, museums, art galleries, bars and the much-loved Quadrangle. Most of the University's faculties and many student-related services can also be found there, such as the Student Centre, Student Services and the Careers Centre.

A short walk across City Road leads you to the Darlington Campus, where you will find the University of Sydney Union's Wentworth Building. Food outlets, campus bookstores and bank branches fill Wentworth, making it a popular lunch-time location. Darlington is also the site of the Sports and Aquatic Centre, the faculties of Architecture, Design and Planning, Engineering and Information Technologies and Economics and Business and the International Office, the support centre for all of the University's international students.

2 Cumberland Campus

Home to the Faculty of Health Sciences, the Cumberland Campus is located at Lidcombe, approximately 16km west of Camperdown. Only a 20-minute train ride from the city, Health Sciences students will find a friendly atmosphere, spacious, landscaped grounds and ultra-modern facilities in which to complete their studies.

3 Sydney College of the Arts (SCA)

The Sydney College of the Arts can be found in our Rozelle Campus, just a 15-minute bus ride from the city and a short stroll from Balmain, a suburb of Sydney known for its markets, restaurants, boutique art galleries and flair. The historic buildings on this campus provide an inspiring location for creating art in a variety of mediums. The creative atmosphere is combined with specialised facilities for photography, printmedia, film and digital art.

4 Sydney Conservatorium of Music

Residing within the Royal Botanic Gardens and just a stroll from the famous Sydney Opera House, 'The Con' is a heritage building that was once the stables for Government House. Since receiving award-winning renovations, the new facility is regarded as one of the finest in the world, with five performance venues

and more than 130 teaching and practice studios. Its facilities include a series of studios and computer laboratories providing users with state-of-the-art equipment for music notation and electronic music production. A fully-equipped recording studio enables digital quality recording and live broadcasts from the Conservatorium venues.

5 Mallett Street Campus

The Faculty of Nursing and Midwifery is located at Mallett Street Campus, where a number of exciting combined nursing degrees are taught. Numerous bus routes service the campus, which is just up the road from Camperdown and a few minutes' walk from Newtown, a favourite student haunt.

6 Sydney Law School

Currently in the heart of the city's legal precinct, the St James Campus is home to Australia's first law school and is easily accessible from a number of City Circle train stations. In 2009, the University will open the doors to the new Law School, an exciting addition to our Camperdown Campus. With a frontage to Victoria Park and the CBD beyond, the building will create a new gateway to the University.

7 The Dental School

Recently refurbished and located adjacent to Central Station in Surry Hills, the campus is home to the four-year graduate dentistry program and our undergraduate oral health program.

8 Camden Campus

Located 65km south-west of the Camperdown Campus, Camden has extensive farms and research units. These facilities are used by Agriculture and Veterinary Science students to enhance their studies.

9 Burren Street Campus

In the heart of Newtown and a short stroll from Camperdown, this campus is home to the Institute of Transport and Logistic Studies. The Institute sits within the Faculty of Economic and Business and uses the most up-to-date technology and facilities at its Burren Street location.
