

Scholarships

At the University of Sydney, we offer a wide variety of scholarships to talented, creative and involved students to reward them for academic achievement and to assist them in obtaining their education. We believe that a university education should be available to those who deserve it, regardless of their financial means.

University-wide scholarships

A large number of scholarships are offered to students enrolling in any faculty of the University. For some, students will need to fill out an application; others are awarded automatically. Many of these scholarships reward achievements in the community as well as academic performance. The University also offers equity scholarships to students who have faced disadvantage during their schooling.

Scholarships for Outstanding Achievement

For: Students with a top-ranked UAI, IB or equivalent interstate qualification.
Duration: For the duration of the degree.
Value: \$10,000 per annum for the duration of the degree.

University of Sydney Merit Scholarships

For: Students who demonstrate superior skills in areas such as leadership, creativity and communication and who have a UAI of 95 or higher. Interstate and IB students are also eligible.
Duration: For the duration of the degree.
Value: \$5,000 per annum for the duration of the degree.
Applications are due in late September; check the Scholarships website for application forms and further information: www.usyd.edu.au/scholarships.

University of Sydney Entry Scholarships

For: Students who demonstrate superior skills in areas such as leadership, creativity and communication and who have a UAI of 95 or higher. Interstate and IB students are also eligible.
Duration: One year.

Value: \$5,000.
Applications are due in late September; check the Scholarships website for application forms and further information www.usyd.edu.au/scholarships.

University of Sydney Access Scholarships

For: Students with a good academic record who have been disadvantaged financially or have a disability or have relocated from a rural area of Australia.
Duration: For the duration of the degree.
Value: \$5,000 per annum for the duration of the degree.
How to apply: Through UAC – consult the UAC booklet or website www.uac.edu.au.
Applications usually close in late September.

Commonwealth Scholarships

For: Students with demonstrated financial disadvantage. Other factors, such as medical disability or relocating from a rural or regional area of Australia, will be taken into consideration.
Duration: Maximum four years.
Value: \$2,162 (indexed) per annum, or \$4,324 (indexed) per annum for recipients relocating from rural or regional areas.
How to apply: Through UAC – consult the UAC booklet or website www.uac.edu.au.
Applications usually close in late September.

University of Sydney National Scholarship

While school leavers throughout Australia are eligible for all University of Sydney scholarships, the University recognises the additional expense and dislocation involved in moving away from home to study at Uni.
For: Students from outside of NSW and the ACT who have received a University

of Sydney Outstanding Achievement Scholarship, University of Sydney Merit or Entry Scholarship, or a University of Sydney Access Scholarship.

Duration: The same duration as your principal scholarship.
Value: \$5,000 per annum on top of the value of your principal scholarship.
How to apply: You do not need to apply for these scholarships although you must have a preference for the University of Sydney on your UAC application and have received an offer of one of the scholarships listed above to be eligible. You will be contacted when the results are released if you meet the eligibility criteria.

Faculty, sporting and other scholarships

As well as participating in the University-wide scholarship programs, many faculties also provide their own scholarships for first-year students. Further scholarships are available for students with outstanding sporting ability; Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students; students undertaking an additional honours year; and students who want to study overseas. New scholarship opportunities become available throughout the year.
