**Denison Miller Postgraduate Memorial Travelling Scholarship
Conditions of Award**

The scholarship, which is to promote the graduate study of economics, was founded in 1924 by a gift of about £1500 from the executive committee of the Denison Miller Memorial Fund established in memory of Sir Denison Miller, the first Governor of the Commonwealth Bank of Australia.

The scholarship is awarded under the following conditions:

1. The scholarship shall be known as the Denison Miller Postgraduate Memorial Travelling Scholarship.
2. The scholarship shall be open to graduates of the Faculty of Economics and Business of the University of Sydney who propose to continue their studies or research in economics at an institution abroad approved by the Faculty.
3. The award shall be made by the Academic Board on the recommendation of a committee appointed by the Faculty of Economics and Business, and provided that the candidate's work is of sufficient merit.
4. The scholarship may be held in conjunction with any other award and may be in the form of a supplementary living allowance or grant-in-aid.
