**Farrington-Thorpe Scholarship
Conditions of Award**

Established in 1983 by a bequest from Mrs Harriet Daisy Finlayson who died in 1933. The purpose of the bequest, which was subject to certain life interests, was to establish a postgraduate scholarship in history, tenable outside Australia, as a memorial to Mrs Finlayson's mother, Mrs Farrington-Thorpe. The scholarship is awarded under the following conditions:

1. The name of the scholarship shall be the Farrington-Thorpe Scholarship.
2. The scholarship is open to—
 - (a) full-time postgraduate students currently enrolled in the University of Sydney in the Department of History for whom it is academically desirable to spend time outside Australia as part of their candidature; and
 - (b) graduates of the University of Sydney who proceed outside Australia to undertake research work in history and who are unable to meet the total costs from other funds, which may include travelling scholarships or travel grants.
3. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Board on the recommendation of the Committee comprising the Head of the Department of History and two other members of the Department of History, nominated by the Head of the Department.
4. The committee shall take into account each applicant's academic record and the merit of the proposed program of study or research.
5. The scholarship may be held in conjunction with any other award and may be in the form of a supplementary living allowance or grant-in-aid.
5. The value of the award shall be determined by the committee.
