Senate Minutes Summary, 14 May 2001

At the special meeting on 14 May 2001:

47/01 By-laws

Senate passed the following resolution:

That the University of Sydney By-Law 1999 under the *University of Sydney Act 1989* be amended forthwith by the addition of the following by-laws 9(2)A, 9(2)B, 11(2)A and 11(2)B:

“9(2)A It is a condition on which the Chancellor holds office that he or she retains the confidence of the Senate and the Chancellor shall cease to hold office if the Senate decides by resolution passed at two consecutive ordinary meetings of the Senate that the Chancellor does not have the confidence of the Senate.

9(2)B This by-law applies to:

- (a) the Chancellor holding office at the date when this by-law comes into effect; and
- (b) all subsequent holders of that office.”

“11(2)A It is a condition on which the Deputy Chancellor holds office that he or she retains the confidence of the Senate and the Deputy Chancellor shall cease to hold office if the Senate decides by resolution passed at two consecutive ordinary meetings of the Senate that the Deputy Chancellor does not have the confidence of the Senate.

11(2)B This by-law applies to:

- (a) the Deputy Chancellor holding office at the date when this by-law comes into effect; and
- (b) all subsequent holders of that office.”

48/01 Notice of Motion
